Achievement Series allows districts to create an unlimited number of items and tests, which can be aligned to state standards and/or to the Common Core Standards. By aligning to both sets of standards, a report on both of these standards can be generated from a single test. This enables the school district to administer one test to all students, and track accountability across state standards and Common Core Standards.

Common Core State Standards (CCSS) Focus

In addition to the ability to create and align your own content, Scantron offers school districts pre-built tests (Assessments) and items (Item Banks) written specifically to the CCSS. The Assessment offering can be used in one of two ways. The first model offers two versions of each assessment at each grade level—a pretest and a post-test. Scantron builds these tests for you and prepares them in your site for immediate administration, so you can begin tracking student results at once. In the second model, the targeted item banks are activated for educators to build their own tests. This model provides the flexibility to make shorter or longer tests, and custom items or items from other item banks. The Common Core Item Bank offering contains over 2,400 items in grades K-12 in Mathematics and English Language Arts. This option allows educators the flexibility to create their own tests, using high quality CCSS items.

Each of Scantron's state and CCSS options provides flexibility for a district to move towards the Common Core Standards at its own pace, and maintain dual accountability tracking of state and Common Core Standards indefinitely. This allows districts to satisfy multiple reporting and tracking needs, all with one assessment.



Scantron's Performance Series is a research-based, criterion-referenced computer-adaptive test that lets K-12 educators quickly pinpoint the instructional level of students across a range of subjects.

This provides for more accurate student placement, diagnosis of instructional needs, measurement of student growth across semesters or years, and it also enables school or district level program evaluation.

Performance Series can be aligned to specific state standards, to the Common Core State Standards or to a custom combination of both sets of standards. Both the standard alignment and district-directed alignment provide students with a targeted assessment experience and provide teachers with reports to empower them to drive instruction using either set of

standards, as well as the ability to track their lessons by both. Customization and reporting code display allow districts to easily transition from their current standards to the Common Core—or to use a combination of both.
