Explanation of severity degrees:

Language	Error in text or grammar without functional effects
Minor	Functional error with a complete workaround
Medium	Functional Error with an incomplete or missing workaround
Severe	Software error causing deterioration or loss of data
Critical	Software error causing instability or a complete halt of the system
New Feature	Functional improvement

<b>Area</b>	<b>Severity</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>VividForms Editor – Multiple Choice</b>	<b>Severe</b>	If multiple choice options were added to an existing multiple choice question, these options were neither displayed on the HTML-Report nor in the CSV-Export. In this case all options of the question were affected; therefore the whole question was not displayed. The PDF-Report was not affected.
<b>Substitute Instructors</b>	<b>Severe</b>	A white screen appeared when using courses with names or course ID that contained apostrophes.
<b>Batch Printing</b>	<b>Severe</b>	An error message appeared when starting a batch print job on courses with names that contained apostrophes.
<b>VividForms – Instructor’s Optional Questions</b>	<b>Severe</b>	Surveys which were done using the instructor’s optional questions procedure were not included in the reports for deans, deans of studies and the president.
<b>Calendar for scheduled Events (French Version)</b>	<b>Severe</b>	The calendar for the configuration of scheduled events did not show up if the system language was set to French.
<b>Scheduled Events</b>	<b>Medium</b>	Scheduled events did not start if the time was set to midnight.
<b>Batch Events – PDF-Report-Generation</b>	<b>Medium</b>	The order of surveys processed by the batch printing procedure was random. Now the order of surveys is aligned to the listing of surveys shown in the configuration box.
<b>Question Library - Export</b>	<b>Medium</b>	The export of the question library failed if abstentions were used in questions.
<b>CSV-Import</b>	<b>Medium</b>	If courses were marked for deletion during the CSV-import the system could show a white screen. This was caused by courses which had surveys in the past that were deleted.
<b>Instructor’s Optional Questions</b>	<b>Medium</b>	Survey participants were not able to see results for surveys if the related questionnaire was used in the Instructor’s Optional Questions procedure.

<b>System Information</b>	<b>Medium</b>	Surveys which were conducted using the Instructor's Optional Questions procedure were not included in the system information statistics. Only the surveys of the original questionnaire were included.
<b>Utilization Statistics</b>	<b>Minor</b>	Occasionally the Apache web server suffered a recoverable failure when the utilization statistics page was displayed.
<b>Subunit Administrators</b>	<b>Minor</b>	As Subunit Administrator it was not possible to open a cover sheet from the "details for survey" page.
<b>Questionnaire – Translation</b>	<b>Minor</b>	If a translated questionnaire contained abstention fields with no text content, the abstention fields disappeared when switching between languages.
<b>CSV-Import</b>	<b>Minor</b>	During CSV-Import a course was misleadingly marked as new even if a course with the same name already existed. This was the case if the imported course name contained special characters, like "&".
<b>Language Sets</b>	<b>Minor</b>	The Language Sets could not be displayed if the Class Climate system was configured to HTTPS only.
<b>VividForms Editor</b>	<b>Minor</b>	The order of elements for Extended Pole Labels could not be modified after the object was created.
<b>PDF-Report</b>	<b>Language</b>	Misalignment of text could be displayed if a very high number of courses were compared with each other using profile line comparison options.
<b>PDF-Report</b>	<b>Language</b>	Special characters were not displayed correctly if diagram types were different from the default histogram type were used.
<b>Module Evaluation</b>	<b>Language</b>	User accounts of the type "Module" cannot be activated anymore.
<b>Preview for Online Surveys</b>	<b>Language</b>	The preview of online surveys did not work under certain circumstances.
<b>Trending Reports</b>	<b>Language</b>	Special characters were not displayed correctly on trending graphs.
<b>Utilization Statistics</b>	<b>Language</b>	The field for last login of a user contained the present date in cases when a user never logged in before. This is now corrected.
<b>PDF-Report</b>	<b>New Feature</b>	If a questionnaire contained multiple open ended questions with equal text it was not easy to identify the corresponding chapter. Now the question ID is displayed next to the question text. It is required to activate question numbering in the PDF-Report options to use this feature.
